

Designing Slippers with Chinese Cultural Elements

The slippers I designed are a pair of panda slippers. They are green, featuring a panda design. I chose pandas because they are native to China and are considered the national treasure. The color green represents nature, reflecting pandas' love for bamboo, which is their main food, including bamboo leaves, stems, and shoots. Pandas have round, cone-shaped teeth that allow them to break strong bamboo poles. They need to consume a lot of food each day, requiring 4,300 to 5,500 calories, which is equivalent to about 20 bowls of rice or 20 hamburgers.
